Concept:

[CHALLENGE University](#) is a two day training workshop prepared for the university students.

First day of the event will be open to all audience and will be focused on lectures about Sustainable mobility planning given by CHALLENGE experts. Morning of the second day will be closed for the working groups and their preparation of case study; the afternoon part of the last day with presentation of the student's work will be again open to all.

Participants can express their interest to be involved in the working group session. Each working group should consist from 6 students (ideally one representative of each faculty/department) and will be lead by a PhD student.

The aim of the training session is to tackle the issues of sustainable urban mobility planning. Students in working group will prepare the tasks which should be solved in case study for area in Brno.

The language of the workshop is English.

Participation is free of charge.

starting with SUMP Challenge Training Workshops for the Partner and Follower Cities from July 2013 to July 2014. National SUMP Challenge Seminars will then take place in the Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, Romania and Croatia between July 2014 and March 2016. An additional SUMP Seminar will be held in Slovenia. These national seminars are open to all interested planners, implementers, decision-makers and multipliers.

In addition to that, the five CH4LLENGE Universities for students and graduates in the five participating Central and Eastern Europe countries will be held between summer 2014 and autumn 2015. All these face-to-face training activities will be complemented by an e-learning course consisting of several modules on each of the four challenges, which CH4LLENGE is developing.
